The financial changes proposed will be :

a) All new members fee for 2021 will be \$105. That includes: joining fee \$30, annual fee, name tag, club shirt, bag tag and VVGA registration and booklet.

The Annual Subscription fee for new members will be \$40 for 2021.

b) Our tournaments will be conducted as a two tier system.

The major courses to be structured at \$60 per round

The second tier courses will be at \$55 per round.

Golf fee when playing on your home course will be \$15.

These will include your lunch and the major draws on the completion of the round.

Our Captain, Harold Hayes has made requests for Shot Gun starts at all venues.

c) The introduction of a 'Tap & Go' system for payment of our golf day fees, instead of using the envelope system. Reduces the need to handle cash.
